"The wonderful thing about the Studio projects is that the processes are inclusive of all abilities," said Cayla Childs, director of communications and special initiatives for the STARability Foundation. "There are many different steps, so there's something that any and every individual can contribute. The candle process, for example, ranges from assembling the wicks, to measuring various elements, to melting and pouring the wax, to completing different stages of packaging. Our participants are responsible for the whole process from start to finish."

The candles' custom-blended scents were designed for the purpose of creating sanctuary spaces. The Finding Sanctuary candles, which are hand-poured in recycled glass containers, are available in two scents. Grounding has a combination of lavender, bergamot, sandalwood and white sage. Soothing offers a combination of lavender and vetiver and was inspired by the relaxation of a walk on the beach.
